In an effort to reduce potential joint tax liability problems of separated or divorced couples, the Department of Revenue is announcing an administrative initiative that allows a spouse or former spouse to submit a written request asking the Department to provide notification regarding an examination of a joint return or collection activity when the other spouse or former spouse has been contacted by the Department.
