**PENALTY**

Failure to file a return will result in a penalty of 5% for the first month plus 5% for each additional month not to exceed a total of 25%. Failure to pay will result in penalties of 0.5% per month not to exceed 25%. Other penalties may apply.

**INTEREST**

Interest on all overdue accounts will be assessed at the rate provided under Sections 6621 and 6622 of the Internal Revenue Code. Rates will change quarterly depending on the prime rate. Interest will be compounded daily.
