INSTRUCTIONS

Utility and railroad companies are required to file this return and the following information by the last day of the fourth month following the close of their accounting period:

- Distribution information, broken down by the gross investment made in each taxing district, reported on your PT-427, Distribution Information for Utility Companies and PT-429, Distribution Information for Rural Telephone Companies.
- A copy of one of the following based on your industry type:
 - The annual Utility or Railroad Report you file with the South Carolina Public Service Commission
 - o Your company's annual financial report
 - o Your USDA-REA Financial and Statistical Report (Form 7)
 - o Any annual report you file with a federal regulation board
- A certification of pollution control equipment including a gross investment and depreciation schedule.
- A list of licensed vehicles including an investment and depreciation schedule.
- A complete explanation of the method used to determine exempt property.
- A schedule of construction work in progress that was capitalized for South Carolina. A separate list between real and personal property is required.
- A detailed list of non-operating (non-utility) real property sorted by tax map number.
