INDIVIDUAL INCOME TAX REBATE**

You may be eligible for a rebate if you filed a 2021 Individual Income Tax return (SC1040) by October 17, 2022 with a tax liability after nonrefundable and refundable credits.

If you received a refund by direct deposit for the 2021 tax year, your rebate will be deposited to the same account. Complete this form if your bank account information has changed. You will receive a paper check instead of direct deposit.

If you received a refund by paper check or debit card, or if you had a balance due for the 2021 tax year, your rebate will be mailed as a paper check to the address we have on file. Complete this form if you need to update your mailing address.

**You must complete and email this form to SCDOR by November 1, 2022.**

**If your direct deposit information or mailing address have not changed since you filed your 2021 Individual Income Tax Return, do not complete this form.**
