SUBJECT: Policy Document Index

SCOPE: An Information Letter is a document issued for the purpose of disseminating general information or information concerning an administrative pronouncement.

Information Letters issued to disseminate general information have no precedential value and do not represent the official position of the Department. Information Letters designated as administrative pronouncements represent the official advisory opinion of the Department.

The index of South Carolina Revenue Rulings, Revenue Procedures, Private Letter Rulings, Technical Advice Memorandum, and Information Letters is now available. Documents issued by the Department of Revenue that pertain to taxation are indexed from 1987 to December 31, 1996. Documents pertaining to alcoholic beverage licensing and regulation are indexed from July 1, 1993 (the date the newly formed Department of Revenue was created) to December 31, 1996.

In addition, a citator of South Carolina policy documents is available for policy documents that have been issued from 1987 to March 31, 1996. This list provides assistance in determining what effect current law and new policy documents have on previously published policy documents.
