# EVENTS & FESTIVALS

### Who needs a Retail License?

A Retail License is required for any person who sells tangible personal property at retail, or provides taxable services in South Carolina. You're required to have a Retail License whether you make sales online or in-person. If you are only planning to hand out promotional items and won't be making sales, you do not need a Retail License. Keep in mind that your South Carolina Retail License is separate from any city and county licensing requirements.

# Do I need a Retail License for markets, shows, fairs, or festivals?

Events fall into one of two categories. Whether or not you need a Retail License at an event depends whether you're at a Special Event or a Retail Event.

- Special Event: Admissions fee is required for entering the event. If you make sales in South Carolina MORE THAN ONCE in a 24-month period, you need an SC Retail License.
  - If you make sales at a Special Event in South Carolina ONLY ONCE in a 24-month period, you do not need a Retail License.
- Retail Event: Admissions fee is not required for entering the event. You always need an SC Retail License to sell at Retail Events.

### What is Sales Tax?

Sales Tax is imposed on the sale of goods and certain services in South Carolina. The statewide Sales and Use Tax rate is 6%. Counties may have additional local taxes if approved by voters in that county. Generally, all retail sales are subject to Sales Tax.

## Do I qualify for an Artist & Craftsman's License?

### Here are the requirements:

- The person making the sales must be an artist or crafter.
- The products for sale must have been crafted or assembled by the artist or crafter selling them.
- The products must **only** be sold at art & crafts shows, festivals, or similar special events.
