

Amended Returns

Use Form SC1040X to correct or change a previously filed SC1040 return.



Use the most current form version found on our website, dor.sc.gov.

Amended returns cannot be submitted electronically.

Extensions

File requests on or before April 15 or before the original due date of a fiscal year return.



File an extension and pay a balance due online at dor.sc.gov or by paper, Form SC4868.

Income Tax Tips



Mark your calendar -

Income tax returns are due April 15. Don't let the date sneak up on you.



Choose your filing system -

Whether paper or electronic, weigh your options and decide which format works best for you.



Gather necessary documents and information -

Round up your W-2s, receipts, SSNs, and forms. Keep a folder in a safe place where you can put these documents throughout the year.



Organize your documents -

Separating medical bills, property tax receipts, mortgage interest payments and other receipts will be extremely helpful for you or your tax preparer.



Make time for your taxes -

Set aside time to go through your paperwork carefully to minimize possible calculation errors.

Filing Options

South Carolina Individual Income Tax Returns may be filed by paper or electronically via our free file options, standard cost options, and fillable forms option. Visit dor.sc.gov/services/electronic for more information.

Payment Options

If you file a return and have a balance due, you can conveniently pay:

- 1 Online using ePay (credit card or electronic funds withdrawal)
- 2 Mail (check or money order only)
- 3 In person (at any SCDOR Taxpayer Service Center)

Direct Deposit

Refund is deposited in your bank account

You will need your nine-digit SSN and your expected refund amount.
