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### What is Nexus?

Nexus means there is enough connection between South Carolina and a business that the business is required to pay SC taxes.

### This connection could be:

- a business activity
- a transaction
- owning property

Taxpayers can participate in the Nexus Discovery Program (NDP) for a tax that they are not currently registered or filing for.

Non-business Individual Income Taxes are not eligible for participation.

## How do I know my Nexus status?

Complete the Nexus Questionnaire on our free and secure tax portal, MyDORWAY, to determine your Nexus status. The SCDOR will contact you to let you know if you have Nexus or not.

# What are my next steps?

If you believe you had South Carolina Nexus for a period where you did not file returns and make payments as required, contact us and request consideration for a Voluntary Disclosure Agreement (VDA). A VDA allows unregistered taxpayers can come forward voluntarily in an informal process and begin paying taxes plus interest without incurring penalties.

- If you want to enter into a Nexus agreement with more than one state, you can apply to the Multistate Tax Commission (MTC) National Nexus Program.
