



## NOTICE OF ELECTION FOR SUPPLIERS AND PERMISSIVE SUPPLIERS

Licensed suppliers and permissive suppliers may make a blanket election to collect the South Carolina Motor Fuel User Fee on removals from out-of-state terminals with a destination within South Carolina. See SC Code Section 12-28-910 for more information. The election must be made by filing a notice of election with the SCDOR.

This requirement is not dependent on the license status of the person acquiring the motor fuel, the point of delivery, the terms of sale, or the character of the delivery.
