

Taxpayers are required to file their Wine Importer Report electronically. File on MyDORWAY.dor.sc.gov, our secure online tax portal.

Create a MyDORWAY account or login to get started. If you do not file electronically, you will receive a penalty. This electronic mandate went into effect beginning with the December 2022 filing period.

This document provides general information about the Wine Importer Report.

WHO NEEDS TO FILE

- Importers of wine into the state of South Carolina

WHEN TO FILE

- **Due date:** The Wine Importer Report is due by the 10th day of the month following each filing period. (For example, your January report is due by February 10.)
- **Frequency:** You must file your Wine Importer Report monthly.
- You must file a Wine Importer Report for each filing period even if you have no sales or purchases for the filing period.

WHAT YOU WILL NEED WHEN YOU FILE

You will need the following information for the filing period:

- Your File Number, Federal Employer ID Number (FEIN), and South Carolina ID (SID)
- The unit type, quantity, volume, and the number of cases of wine imported during the filing period
- Corresponding invoices for the filing period
